

CALL FOR APPLICATION TO THE POST-DEGREE II-LEVEL MASTER PROGRAM IN DEVELOPMENT, MANUFACTURING, AND AUTHORIZATION OF BIOPHARMACEUTICALS 3rd EDITION - Academic Year 2024/2025

THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF LIFE SCIENCES

- HAVING REGARD TO the Statute of the University of Modena and Reggio Emilia, issued by Rector's Decree no. 86 of 26th January 2023, Prot. 19456 of 26th January 2023;
- CONSIDERING the Ministerial Decree no. 270 of 22 October 2004 which made modifications to the Regulation regarding the didactic autonomy of universities, approved by Decree of the Ministry of Universities and Scientific and Technological Research no. 509 of 3rd November 1999, and published in G.U. no. 266 of 12th November 2004; it is worth considering the implications of these changes;
- CONSIDERING the Interministerial Decree of July 9th, 2009, which establishes the equivalence between degrees of the old system, specialist degrees, and master's degrees;
- CONSIDERING the Interministerial Decree of 11 November 2011, published in the Official Gazette n. 44 of 22/02/2012, which made clear that the diplomas obtained from the three-year Schools for Special Purposes established under Presidential Decree 162/1982 and the three-year University Diplomas established under Law 341/1990 are equivalent to the degrees of the classes D.M. 509/1999 and D.M. 270/2004, for certain competitions;
- HAVING REGARD TO the Didactic Regulations of the University;
- HAVING REGARD TO the University's regulations governing post-graduate professional master's programmes, professional courses, and state exams;
- HAVING REGARD TO the Prot. n. 17188 of 13rd November 2009 "Ministero dell'Istruzione, dell'Università e della Ricerca, Dipartimento per l'istruzione, Direzione generale per il personale scolastico, Ufficio III, sulla compatibilità tra corsi universitari";
- HAVING REGARD TO Law No. 33 of April 12, 2022, and its implementing decrees, which starting from the academic year 2022/2023 allow the simultaneous enrollment of students in two study programs, even at multiple universities and institutions of higher artistic, musical, and choreographic education (AFAM), both Italian and foreign;
- HAVING REGARD TO the provisions of MIUR protocol n. 602 of 18 May 2011, which concerns the enrolment of EU and non-EU students in Italian state and non-state universities authorized to issue qualifications with legal value;
- HAVING REGARD TO art. 15 of Law no. 183 of 12 November 2011, "Rules on certificates and declarations in lieu of certificates";
- HAVING REGARD TO Presidential Decree No. 445 of 28 December 2000, which contains the "Consolidated text of legislative and regulatory provisions on administrative documentation.";
- ACCORDING TO Article 32 of Law No. 69, dated 18 June 2009, the disposal of paper documents is mandatory;
- HAVING REGARD TO the resolution of the Department of Life Sciences of February 22nd, 2024, which approved the Post-Degree II-level Master Program;



HAVING REGARD TO the resolution of the Academic Senate and the Board of Directors during their respective meetings on March 14th and 22nd, 2024, the Master program for the academic year 2024/2025 has been approved for activation;

ARTICLE 1 - Establishment

By D.M. 270 of 22/10/2004, the University of Modena and Reggio Emilia activates for the Academic Year 2024/2025, the Post-Degree II-level University Master Program in *Development, Manufacturing, and Authorization of Biopharmaceuticals.*

AUDITORS

It is possible to participate in the Master Program as an Auditor.

Those interested can apply as auditors directly to the organizational office of the master (email <u>master.biopharmaceuticals@unimore.it</u>) by sending the pre-enrolment form (<u>Annex C to this</u> <u>document</u>) which must be submitted by the deadline indicated in the admission announcement. Once the activation of the master has been confirmed, a request for completion of enrolment will be sent with the simultaneous payment of the enrolment fee.

The organizational office of the master will inform those interested directly of the acceptance of the application as well as the timing and process for the enrolment and payment of the fee for participation in the Master as auditors.

The Auditors do not take the final exam, are not obliged to attend, do not participate in the internship, are not obliged to prepare the project work, do not acquire the title of II level University Master Programme in Development, Manufacturing, and Authorization of Biopharmaceuticals, and do not acquire CFU. The organizing secretariat will issue the auditor a certificate of attendance.

Professional profile that the Master Programme intends to train: Over the last decade, radical changes in products developed and marketed by the biopharmaceutical industry, as well as a growing interest in improving the efficiency and effectiveness of production, have encouraged an evolution in the technologies and processes in use to produce the latest generation of biopharmaceutical products. The Master aims to train experts able to manage laboratories' different industrial development processes with biotechnological and pharmacological characterization, to respond to the growing demand for highly qualified operators from companies and institutions in the sector. The master aims to prepare specialized personnel with a high level of gualification, able to cover various professional positions within the biopharmaceutical drugs world. These professionals will be qualified as: Manager/Director of laboratories with biotechnological pharmacological and characterization. Coordinator of development and monitoring programs of applied biotechnologies in human health, regarding the industrial development of biopharmaceutical products, the industrial aspects of biotechnological drugs production, and the management of scientific and process-related data with artificial Intelligence (AI). Expert in management of the regulatory aspects of the market authorizations, of the ethical and legal implications of the marketing of biopharmaceuticals with aspects of environmental protection and sustainability.

The Master is divided into five teaching modules that develop the following themes:

- Module I Development and Manufacturing
- Module II Clinical Studies
- Module III Data Management and Exploitation
- Module IV Regulatory
- Module V Market Access and Sustainability

Duration and location: annual.

Classes will take place in streaming through a dedicated platform starting from October 2024, generally on Fridays (from 9.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. and from 2.00 p.m. to 6.00 p.m.) and Saturdays (from 9.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m.).

Once every four/six weeks class will take place at Unimore's Department of Life Sciences in Via Campi 103, Modena, and will be available in streaming through a dedicated platform.

All lessons, lectures, and communications will be held entirely in English.

The Master includes a curricular internship of 375 hours that the participant can carry out in private and public organizations that collaborate with the Unimore Department of Life Sciences.

The Master Program includes intermediate tests, which include 5 multiple-choice quizzes and 3 open questions of 300 words, and a final examination that involves a thesis discussion (approximately in September 2025). The thesis work is performed by the Candidate on a subject of choice that can also be related to the training performed during the internship period.

Enrolment fee for students who have obtained their degree no later than 3 years before the time of expiry of this call for applications ($\in 2,000.00$ first installment when concluding the enrolment procedure; $\in 2,000.00$ second installment, by <u>December 20^{th,} 2024</u>).

AUDITORS' FEE

It is possible to register for one or more modules of the Master's program with the following options:

- €1,700.00 registration fee for module I *Development and Manufacturing* of the Master's Program, to be paid in one solution, concurrently with registration;
- €500.00 registration fee for module II *Clinical Studies* of the Master's Program, to be paid in one solution, concurrently with registration;
- €1,500.00 registration fee for module IV *Regulatory* of the Master's Program, to be paid in one solution, concurrently with registration;
- €500.00 registration fee for module V *Market Access and Sustainability* of the Master's Program, to be paid in one solution, concurrently with registration.

Registration for individual modules as an auditor must occur before the start of the lessons scheduled for the module of interest, by completing Annex C and sending it to the master's secretariat at <u>masterbiopharmaceuticals@unimore.it</u>.

After the activation of the Master Program is confirmed, the office will send a request to interested auditors for finalization of registration, which should be accompanied by payment of the registration fee. The secretariat will communicate directly with interested parties regarding the acceptance of the request as well as the timing and procedures for registration and payment of the participation fee for the Master's program.

Auditors do not take the final and intermediate exams, do not participate in the internship, are not obligated to prepare the project work, do not acquire the title of Second-level University Master's Degree in Expert in Development, Manufacturing, and Authorization of



Biopharmaceuticals, and do not acquire Universitary CFU credits. Auditors will be issued an Attendance Certificate.

Total hours:

The Master Programme is structured in 1500 hours, for a total of 60 CFU:

- 240 hours of lectures;
- 375 hours of internship;
- 125 hours for the final test;

and the remaining hours in individual study.

Teaching staff: The Master Programme teaching staff consists of experienced professionals and experts in the topics covered



Selection procedure: Curriculum Vitae et Studiorum evaluation and interview.

Selection will be based on qualifications and work experience (50%) and a motivational interview (50%).

Alma Laurea - Data Bank: As a part of its monitoring of university master's courses, the Consorzio Interuniversitario Alma Laurea will invite students enrolled in the Master's Programme to fill in the "Questionnaire on the opinions of those attending the course". The Department of Life Sciences will send an email invitation to the students about a month before the end of the master's course to participate in the survey.



ARTICLE 2 - Admission requirements

The selection process is open to anyone with a qualification obtained in Italy, as specified in Art. 1 of the call, or a similar academic qualification from a foreign university. There are no age or nationality restrictions for participation.

Applicants holding a foreign academic degree (only students possessing the Bachelor and Master degree or an equivalent of 4/5 years university degree study can be admitted, if from non Italian countries) need to send the necessary documents to verify it to the Life Sciences Department at Via Campi 103, 41125 Modena, Italy. These documents should include either a degree certificate with exams or a description of the degree with a list of exams taken, using facsimile Annex B. You should attach these documents to the application using the computer procedure specified in Item 3.

Italian and international students who hold a foreign academic qualification need to provide the following documents by the enrolment deadline, as per the regulations that apply to foreign students' admission:

- A translated and legalized version of their qualification, obtained from the Italian Representation (Embassy or Consulate) in the country where they obtained it.
- A "dichiarazione di valore in loco" which can be requested from the same Representation.

ARTICLE 3 - Applications for admission

Please note that to be considered for the selection procedure, all applications and supporting documents (including qualifications and any other relevant documents) must be submitted to this Administration before the deadline specified in Article 1. Failure to comply with this requirement will result in exclusion from the selection process. Please note that all submissions should be made using the computerised procedure explained below:

 - a. those who have an Italian document such as an ID card, passport, or license, must log in using their SPID credentials (Sistema Pubblico di Identità Digitale). Once the registration process is complete, a username and password will be displayed on the screen, which are the personal credentials for UNIMORE. Make sure to keep these credentials safe as they'll be needed to access other services such as the use of UNIMORE's Wi-Fi.

To apply, a non-refundable fee of € 25,00 must be paid. Failure to pay the fee will result in exclusion from the selection process.

Once the application form is completed and you've saved your data, navigate to the "Tasse" section in esse3 to view the fees you need to pay. Please note that payment must be made before the expiry date indicated in Art. 1 to avoid being excluded. Attention! Following "AgID" Agenzia per l'Italia digitale guidelines the payment operation could be performed the day after the request made by the payer, precluding the admission.

The submission of an admission application will only be considered complete once the data ("Salva i Dati") are saved after the candidate has given their explicit confirmation of the validity of the application. This confirmation should be given at the end of the computer procedure, which is explained in detail in the "Guide to the Application for Admission" linked above.

Anytime before saving and confirming the validity of data ("Salva i dati"), and before the call for application's deadline, applicants can add, modify, or delete the titles and documents by connecting to their esse3 Student Area mentioned above. We recommend consulting the "Guide to the Application for Admission" before doing so. Please note that applications and annexes cannot be submitted by email or fax.

Applications for admission submitted according to the above-mentioned procedures are considered valid only if received by this Administration within the peremptory deadline of the call.



As part of the computerized application process, the candidate will need to provide the following information under their responsibility:

- a. First and last name;
- b. Place and date of birth;
- c. Residence address, phone number, email address;
- d. Fiscal code (if already available), otherwise they'll have to confirm the one automatically generated by the system;
- e. Citizenship;
- f. Details of their academic qualifications or equivalent qualifications obtained from foreign universities, if needed;
- g. The exact name of the Vocational Master Programme they're interested in;
- h. Curriculum Vitae et Studiorum;
- i. Titles and any other relevant documents;
- j. If the candidate has a disability, they'll need to follow the law no. 104 of 5 February 1992 and specify the type of aid required to sit the exams.

By applying for admission, the candidate agrees to the following terms:

- 1. Promptly notify the university of any change of residence or address.
- 2. If the candidate is an Italian citizen or a foreigner with a degree obtained abroad, then it is mandatory to send the degree along with a list of exams taken, Italian translation, legalization, and "declaration of value in situ" by the Italian diplomatic-consular representation competent for the territory. This complies with the current regulations for foreign students' admission to degree courses at Italian universities and must be done within the deadline for enrolment.

Please note that applicants who fail to meet the eligibility requirements may be excluded from consideration at any time, ex officio. Additionally, applications that are submitted or received after the deadline, or in a manner that does not follow the specifications outlined in this notice, will not be considered.

The Administration cannot be held responsible for any loss of communication resulting from incorrect information, failure to provide or late notification of a change of address, technical problems or events caused by third parties, unforeseeable circumstances, or force majeure. Furthermore, the Administration cannot be held responsible for any non-receipt of documents due to actions or errors by third parties, as well as in case of mistakes made by the applicant when inserting attachments, or any instance of network downtime.

TITLES and DOCUMENTS:

Candidates will have to attach, through the <u>informatic system</u>, to the application form:

"Annex A" for candidates in possession of a qualification obtained in Italy, selfcertification of possession of the access requirement under articles 46 and 47 of D.P.R. 445/2000 using the facsimile at the end of the application form;



- "Annex B" for candidates with a degree obtained abroad, a degree certificate with exams or a description of the degree with a list of the exams passed, using if necessary the facsimile at the end of the application form;
- > Titles and documents considered useful for assessment and list thereof;
- > Curriculum vitae et Studiorum;
- > Copy of a valid ID card.

According to Article 15 of Law no. 183 of 12 November 2011, it's important to note that certificates issued by the government regarding status, personal qualities, and facts are only valid and useful in private relations. In dealings with government officials and public service managers, certificates and deeds of notoriety are always replaced by the declarations referred to in Articles 46 and 47.

Certificates obtained from the competent authorities of the State where the qualification was acquired must adhere to the laws and regulations in force in that State. Additionally, they must be translated and legalized by the appropriate Italian consular authorities.

Foreign language documents and deeds must be accompanied by a translation into Italian, attested as complying with the original text, prepared either by the competent Italian diplomatic or consular representative or by an official translator.

ARTICLE 4 - Admission procedures and publication of the ranking list

The selection process is described in Article 1.

Once the selection procedure is complete, the selection committee will create a list that ranks the candidates who applied. Admission to the Master's Programme will be granted to candidates who have submitted the required documents and have been ranked based on their performance, up to the number of available spots in the programme.

The list of admitted candidates will be made public on the online notice board at <u>https://wss.unimore.it/public/albo/</u> and on the University of Modena and Reggio Emilia website at <u>http://www.unimore.it</u> under Didactics, Master's Programmes, and Admitted Graduations.

The Director of the Department of Life Science, Prof. Lorena Rebecchi, will provide admission once the documents have been verified.

<u>Please note that we will not be providing any information over the phone or sending it to</u> your home address.

Enrollment in a Master's Programme is compatible with ongoing enrolment in another course of study, a degree course, a master's degree course, a specialisation course, or a Ph.D. Program, and another university master's program.

Enrolment in a Master's Programme is incompatible with an active training period (TFA).

ARTICLE 5 - Registration of those admitted

Candidates who have been successfully placed in the final merit list must enroll in the Master's Programme within 12 days from the day after the final ranking is published on the University's



online public notice board. This enrollment process must be done exclusively through the informatic procedure. Failure to do so may result in forfeiture.

Before submitting the application form for the Professional Master's Programme, please ensure that you have entered all the required data accurately. Once submitted, print a copy of the application form for your record. A signed copy of the document must be sent to the administrative office as a confirmation of the enrolment.

Head to the "Tasse" section to view the amount of contributions that need to be paid. The payment must be made within the deadline mentioned, failure to do so may result in exclusion from the programme. Payment methods are listed at http://www.unimore.it/ammissione/pagamenti.html

It is important to note that the date of payment indicated on the telematic payment receipt (RT) is the valid date for the University. Please be aware that the payment operation could take up to one day to complete after the request is made, which may cause a delay in registration.

Please ensure that the second installment payment is made before the deadline established in Article 1 of the present call, in the same manner as mentioned above. If the second installment is paid late, a surcharge of \in 30.00 will be applied for up to 15 consecutive and continuous days after the deadline. If the payment is delayed further, a surcharge of \notin 70.00 will be applied from the 16th day onwards.

It is important to note that payment of the first installment and printing of the aforementioned forms do not complete the enrollment process in the Master's Programme.

<u>Candidates who have been selected must submit the required documentation to the</u> Department of Life Sciences (located at Via Giuseppe Campi, 287, Modena, Italy) within twelve days of the publication of the final ranking, failing which they will forfeit their selection. The documentation can be submitted through PEC (dsdv@pec.unimore.it), registered mail with return receipt, or postal courier.

The required documents include:

- a) signed Application Form
- b) receipt of payment of the first installment of the registration fee

Italian and non-Italian citizens who have obtained an academic qualification from a foreign country must submit their degree certificate, including a list of completed exams, along with an Italian translation, legalization, and a "declaration of value in loco" provided by the Italian diplomatic-consular Representation competent for the territory, to the Department of Life Sciences. This is mandatory and must be done before the deadline for enrolment. You can submit the required documents via E-MAIL to <u>masterbiopharmaceuticals@unimore.it</u>. Failure to do so will result in disqualification.



Foreign citizens who do not have a fiscal code yet need to apply for it at the Revenue Office after entering Italy. After applying, they must send a copy of the card issued by the office to the secretary's office within 30 days of the start of the Master's course. The copy should be sent exclusively by email to <u>masterbiopharmaceuticals@unimore.it</u>.

If they fail to comply with the above registration requirements in a timely and accurate manner, they will be considered renounced. False declarations will result in an exclusion from the selection procedure. If there are still vacancies left after the selection procedure is over, applications for admission submitted after the deadline and before the start of classes will be considered, but will require the payment of a late fee of \in 30 for registration.

If the minimum number of enrolled students is not reached, the Master's program will not be activated, and the fees paid will be refunded.

ARTICLE 6 - Attendance procedures

Attendance in class is mandatory, and to be eligible for the degree, the following minimum requirements must be met:

- 75% of the hours of frontal teaching, whether in person or online, must be attended;
- Attendance for a period of no less than 90% of the total duration of the internship is required;
- Students must pass the intermediate verification tests;
- Students must pass the final test.

ARTICLE 7 - University credits and qualifications awarded

The University Post-Degree II-level Master Training Program awards 60 university credits by Art. 1, Paragraph 4 of the D.M.270/2004. Once you pass the final exam, you will receive the title of Post-Degree II-level Master Training Program in <u>Development, Manufacturing, and Authorization of Biopharmaceuticals</u>. Please note that it is important to note that the achievement of the title is subject to compliance with the payment of taxes, contributions, and any surcharges.

ARTICLE 9 - Processing of personal data

As per the current legislation, the University Administration is obligated to use the personal information provided by the candidate to carry out the selection procedure and for institutional purposes.
